The purpose of this cookie policy is to inform you about the cookies and any other similar techniques used on the website(s) of BEKINA. These cookies are used to optimize the functioning of the website and to better tailor the website to your needs and preferences.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are small data or text files that are stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you visit a website. These files contain unique codes that allow your browser to recognize you, so that you are identified as the same user when you revisit our websites, for example.

Cookies can be used to improve the functioning and usability of websites. This includes remembering items in a shopping cart, making logging in easier, or analysing website traffic to improve functionality. They can also be used to map your browsing behaviour, so that the content of a website better matches your preferences and needs.

In addition to regular cookies, we may also use similar technologies, such as flash cookies, tags, cross-device tracking, JavaScripts and web beacons. In accordance with Article 10/2 of the Act of 30 July 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data, these techniques are categorized under the same heading of 'cookies' and are processed in the same way.

3. WHICH COOKIES

3.1. Strictly necessary technical cookies

These cookies are necessary for technical reasons so that you can visit the website. As they are crucial for the website to function, these cookies are automatically placed as soon as you visit the site, with only an obligation to inform.

These cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. Without these cookies the website cannot function properly.

3.2. Functional cookies

Functional cookies are classified as tracking cookies and are used to collect anonymous data about user behaviour and website performance. This information is used solely to optimize the functionality, user experience and performance of the website, without storing any identifiable information.

It is possible to opt out of the use of these cookies. Please note, however, that certain functionalities, such as videos, may not be available if you disable these cookies.

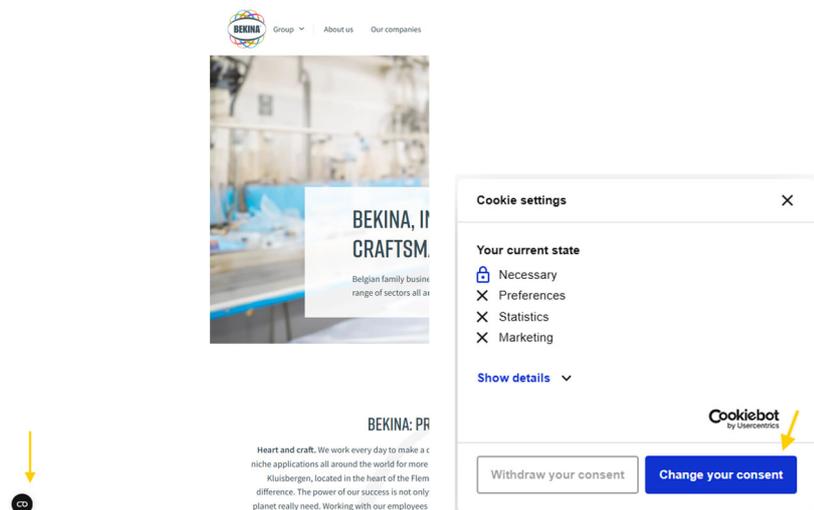
